Christians are commanded to correct each other when one of us falls into sin.

"Brothers, if someone is caught in a sin, you who are spiritual should restore him gently. But watch yourself, or you also may be tempted" (Gal. 6:1).

But who is sufficient for these things? We are all so very frail that we may ourselves be overtaken by a like temptation or worse and fall into sin. Therefore, we ought to deal gently with sinning

brothers instead of judging them harshly. Our weaknesses will be judged more harshly if we judge harshly. If we show mercy, which always "triumphs over justice," the time will surely come when we desire mercy for ourselves.
