Did You Know

Does prayer change God? The answer is yes and no. Prayer doesn't change God's purpose; it does influence his actions. James says, "You don't have because you don't ask." God limits Himself in what He'll do for man according to man's actions; He won't bypass human will. He's not hindered by lack of willingness on His part, but by our failure to ask in faith: "Let a man ask in faith without doubting; a double-minded man ... should not expect anything from God." Consider this imperfect analogy: God has one vote: He wants to do us good. Satan has one vote: He wants to keep God from doing us good. Who'll break the tie? We will. We have the deciding vote, which we cast when we pray in faith. A failure to pray is a failure to vote, so the deadlock remains, and the good that God would do remains undone.
