Here's another "Did You Know"

Thomas Jefferson once wrote: "It does me no injury for my neighbor to say there are twenty gods or no god. It neither picks my pocket nor breaks my leg." Jefferson was probably fortunate in his neighbors, who were almost certainly all Christians. But no society will remain moral and civilized that does not believe in a God to whom people are answerable. As the Christian writer Dostoyevsky wrote: "If there is no God everything is permitted."

A greater than Jefferson, George Washington himself, said: "let us with caution indulge the supposition that morality can be maintained without religion... reason and experience both forbid us to expect that national morality can prevail in exclusion of religious principle." As Christian morality is less honored in our private lives and public institutions, our country has become more and more a place where our neighbor just might pick our pocket or break our legs.
